FACET

Facet is an innovative educational learning tool for couples preparing for marriage, which will help them gain insight into one another and their relationship. It consists of a series of 13 topics containing 174 statements that the couple responds to with "yes," "no," or "uncertain." Under each topic the statements are in categories of "I know," "I believe," and "I will." A unique aspect of FACET is the narrative section. Attached to the answer sheet is a series of open-ended questions or statements that each person completes. The facilitator will ask the couple to bring that part when they return to go over the FACET results, not to read through, but to refer to. These statements allow the couple to begin the conversation before the results are in, and it gives the facilitator further input about where conversation is still needed.
