Hotel Reservations

Directions and Map

A map indicating the location of the Convention Center and hotels is located on the back of the OCEA program. We suggest using an online locator system for specific directions. The addresses for the Convention Center and the hotels are as follows:

1. **Convention Center**: 525 Elm Street, Cincinnati, OH 45202
2. **Hyatt Regency 151**: West Fifth Street, Cincinnati, OH 45202
(Valet Parking = \$20/day; Daily Rate-no overnight stay = \$12.)
3. **Millennium**: 150 West Fifth Street, Cincinnati, OH 45202
(Valet Parking = \$22/day; Daily Rate-no overnight stay = \$12.)
4. **Hilton Cincinnati**: 35 West Fifth Street, Cincinnati, OH 45202
(Valet Parking = \$21/day; Daily Rate-no overnight stay = \$15.)

Liturgy is available at the Cathedral of St. Peter in Chains located at 325 W. Eighth Street, a short two-block walk from the Convention Center, at 7:00 a.m., 11:30 a.m. and 5:15 p.m.

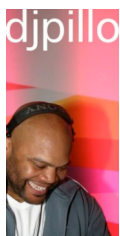
